

Privacy Policy

All personal information is processed in accordance with the principles of data protection contained in the UK Data Protection Act 1998 and Directive 95/46/EC.

What information do we gather?

The type of client/visitor information Parker Consultancy Services collects generally includes:

Specific personal information which you have chosen to communicate to us whether by e-mail, through this website or by other means. This is likely to include name, work address, telephone numbers, e-mail address and any other relevant contact details

Information about your use of our products and services, including any preferences that we are told about, or information that is submitted voluntarily to us, such as requests for further information in a specific area of interest, an on-line survey or registration for a conference or event.

Information which does not personally identify you may also be indirectly collected through Parker Consultancy Services Internet access logs or cookies. This occurs automatically when you access our website. This information is used to enhance your visit to our site. It does not personally identify you.

What are 'cookies'?

- Cookies are identifiers that we transfer to your computer's hard drive through your Web browser to enable our systems to recognise your computer next time you visit and to track usage levels and preferences.
- The Help menu on the menu bar of most browsers will tell you how to prevent your browser from accepting new cookies, how to have the browser notify you when you receive a new cookie and how to disable cookies altogether.

Why does Parker Consultancy Services collect this information and how do we use it?
